1NC	8 min	 Attack affirmative. Make arguments against the specifics of the case. (Case Args) Argue that bad things will happen if the plan is adopted. (Disads) Argue that the aff's fundamental assumptions are flawed. (Critique) Argue that the plan is not a representation of the topic. (Topicality) Argue that there is a better alternative. (Counterplan)
CX	3 min	•1A cross-examines 1N.
2AC	8 min	 Defend affirmative positions and attack negative positions. This is the affirmative's last chance to introduce new issues. Argue that the disads are really reasons to vote aff. (Turns) Argue that the counterplan and affirmative plan can coexist. (Perm)
CX	3 min	•1N cross-examines 2A.
2NC	8 min	 Attack affirmative positions and defend negative positions. This is the negative's last chance to introduce new issues. 2NC and 1NR should cover different issues.
CX	3 min	•2A cross-examines 2N.
1NR	5 min	Attack affirmative positions.Defend negative positions.
1AR	5 min	 Make choice and prioritize arguments. Attack negative positions and defend affirmative positions.
2NR	5 min	•Weigh the issues.
